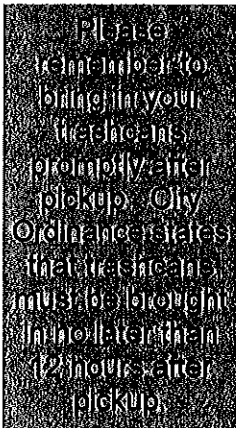

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Be A Good Neighbor

Please keep your animals confined to your property and use a leash when walking them. If you are threatened or attacked by an animal, call Animal Control immediately at 361-3888. Both city and state laws govern dangerous animals. The state law mainly covers dogs and the city law covers any animal.

The Copperfield Homeowners Association has no legal authority over animal control. If you have any questions concerning animal control, contact the City of Bryan Animal Control Department.

The Texas Legislature passed a new animal control law during the last session. It is HB 1355 and is also known as "Lillian's Law". You are responsible for the actions of your animals. Keep them confined to your property at all times when not walking them.

Keep Our Sidewalks Clean

Please remember to carry a bag with you when walking your dogs so that you may clean up after them. Help keep our sidewalks clear of dog mess.
